
Welcome to the Essentials of Ethics.


"Discipline is just like the cherry on the cake to one's character. It can be displayed everywhere, from home to college and returning."

- · Co-operate in synchronized teaching-learning by avoiding unwanted distractions.




- Use words with utmost care. Using abusive language is not about style statements but degrades the college atmosphere. Therefore, college staff will take strict action if students use foul language.
