## **Application Details**

- Forms Availability: Application forms can be collected from the Examination Cell during working hours.
- Last Date for Application (Without Late Fee): 31st December 2025
- Late Fee Applications: Applications submitted after the above dae till the date of exam will attract an additional late fee of ₹1000/-.
- Attendance Defaulters: Fee defaulters are also eligible to appear for special examination with a fee of Rs. 500/-,
- Students who were found guilty of using **unfair means** during regular examinations of Even semester are not eligible to sit for the special exam. However such students from even semesters have to appear for Re-exam
- Detained students with <50% attendance is also **not eligible** for special examination.
