Euphoria 2023 - Report

Euphoria, oh what a sight

A celebration of culture and light

A vibrant display of music and dance

Bringing together people from every chance

Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College of Engineering successfully hosted its Cultural Flagship event, EUPHORIA, from 28th to 31st of March, 2023. The theme for Euphoria 2023 is CELESTIA.

CELESTIA is THE MAGIC OF THE MOON, the theme explores the mystique and allure of the moon, a celebration of the enchanting qualities of the moon, its connection to nature and the power it holds over our imagination.

To heighten the feeling of happiness, the cultural days of Euphoria were separated into the following Days:

24th March, 2023- Rose Day

27th March 2023- Traditional Day

28th March 2023- Group Alike Day

29th March 2023 – Meme Day

This year, the events in Euphoria were divided in three phases of the moons, Phase 1- Amavasya i.e Day 1 of Euphoria, Phase 2- Ardhachandra i.e Day 2 of Euphoria, Phase 3- Purnima i.e Day 3 of Euphoria. The events were divided according to domains and the events were divided into 6 domains.

The first domain Performing Arts is where melodic voices, electrifying moves and comedic wit collide on stage. The first event Rhythmic Rhapsody(English singing) event which included a maximum of 3 individual participants per class. Second event being Sangeet Safar(Hindi Singing) event which included maximum of 3 individual participants per class. Third event On the floor, in this event a duo from each class shall take the stage, each having chosen a unique dance form. The last event Joke Jamboree, a stand-up comedy event where from participation from each class was 1 participant.

The second domain Fine Arts, A captivating and soulful region, offering a limitless canvas for self-expression and creativity. Cosmic Colours the first event in this domain. A face painting event with a team of two and 2 maximum teams from each class. The second event Sketchathon, participants were asked to sketch their interpretation of this year's Euphoria theme with 2 individuals from each class participating. The final event of this domain Mosaic Mirror, "Creating beauty from scraps – Mosaic art with a face!!" participants need to make a mosaic from magazine cut-outs. Maximum participants 2 teams from each class, where each team consisted of 2 members.

The third domain Literary Arts, Words, to create rhythm, rhyme and imagery, evoking peak emotions and encompassing a wide range of mindsets. The first event Adalat -Mock Courtroom, teams playing opposition and proposition with real-life cases given at hand. Each team consisted of 6 members and 1 team from each class was maximum participation. The second event Tamasha, Teams wrote the scripts for the event and also performed them. Each team consisted of 4 members and one team from per class was maximum participants

The Fourth domain Personality, To win, the contestants had to display their personalities and ability to handle themselves. The first event under this domain Roadies X CRCE where the participants were made to fill out a questionnaire which was then followed by an audition judging the participant's overall personality.

The event consisted of a maximum of 5 participants per class. The second being CRCE's Fittest, which consisted of three rounds (Sprint across a predetermined path inside college, arm-wrestling and a strength round consisting of exercises like pistol squats, burpees, pushups and squats). It included a maximum of 3 boys and 3 girls per class. The third event Chehre, Participants had a character allocated to them, and they had to respond to the panel's questions in that character's voice.

The Fifth domain Sports, A portal to new worlds, where players can explore unknown territories, overcome obstacles and uncover hidden treasures, offering a break from reality. The First event ShipWrecks , an event where you sink the opponent's ships and save yours. One team from each class where a team consisted of 2 members. Fifa 22 the second event, a football tournament played between classes using controllers and console. One team per class each consisting of two members.

The final domain Submission, Unleash your boundless creativity and showcase your exceptional skills in the captivating world of pictography, videography and beyond. The first event Stories in a Snap, Each class gets to choose from two topics 1) Phases of life 2) Evolution of mankind and depict a scene from the chosen topic with a detailed caption and catchy title. The second event BE REEL, an event where the participants will have to make a creative montage reel covering the first and second day of 'EUPHORIA'. The final event Sell Me This Pen, Team members from each class will come together to make an advertisement of the brand allotted to them. Each of the events had one submission per class.

The last and final section was the Flagship events for Euphoria 2023. After 3 years, we had the Inter-College Dance Competition 'Paridhan' at Rangsharda auditorium. The second flagship event, IMPULSE i.e the Inter class Dance Competition which took place at RNM. The third one was Glamgala i.e. the renowned inter class Fashion Show at the Rangsharda auditorium. Mr. and Ms. CRCE, an event exclusively for the BE's testing their overall personality, was the final flagship event. The time had come for this was the opportunity to ignite passion and ignite the platform with enthusiasm, liberate their thoughts and emotions, and glide towards the coveted cultural Trophy.
